Written assignments should be turned in together at the close of a course.

- 1. Read *Reading The Gospel of John* in its entirety.
- 2. Listen/watch lectures 1-11.
- 3. Write a four-page double-spaced exegetical paper on John 1:1-3. Consult commentaries, lexicons, and monographs, incorporating at least five written works aside from the assigned reading. Footnote all citations and provide both a cover page and a works cited page. Consult either the Chicago Manual of Style or Turabian for questions of citation and pagination.
- 4. Write a four-page double-spaced paper which explores the motif of water as it appears in the fourth gospel. Explain how this motif appears, its significance, and its application to the church today. This paper should incorporate at least five written works aside from the assigned reading. Footnote all citations and provide both a cover page and a works cited page. Consult either the *Chicago Manual of Style* or Turabian for questions of citation and pagination.
