- 1. Read Baptist Foundations in its entirety.
- 2. Watch/Listen to lectures 1-7.
- 3. Write a two-page double spaced paper which considers the question, "Does the Bible prohibit or allow women to serve in the office of deacon?" This paper should incorporate a consideration of 1 Timothy 3:8-13.
- 4. Write a five to eight-page double-spaced research paper which articulates your position on the function of elders within a local congregation. Your paper should articulate whether you affirm elder ruled polity or elder led congregationism. Provide a biblical basis for your argumentation.

This paper should include at least five written works aside from the assigned reading. Footnote all citations and provide both a cover page and a works cited page. Consult either the *Chicago Manual of Style* or Turabian for questions of citation and pagination.
