- 1. Complete the assigned reading and read the Epistle to the Galatians.
- 2. Listen/watch to the assigned lectures.
- 3. Write a five page Sunday school lesson on Galatians 5:1-12. This lesson should include a detailed outline of the passage and verse by verse commentary.
- 4. Write a five page double-spaced exegetical paper on Galatians 2:15-21. This paper should incorporate at least five commentaries, Bible dictionaries, lexica, etc. other than the assigned reading. Footnote all citations and provide a cover page and works cited page.
